Remembering 9/11

On the morning of September 11, 2001, thousands of firefighter & police officers in New York responded to the terrorist attacks on the World Trade Center. Assigned to evacuate the burning towers, these first responders facilitated the rescue of tens of thousands of people from the World Trade Center complex, saving countless lives. Sadly, 343 New York City Firefighter, 37 Port Authority Police Officers, and 23 New York city Police Officers gave their lives that day. In all 2,977 people were killed in the attacks of September 11, 2001. To commemorate their sacrifice, members of emergency services in Warren County will climb 110 stories (the height of the World Trade Center) on the morning of September 11, 2021 at Spangler Towers Starting at 7:56a.m. This climb symbolizes the climb that these heroes died completing.

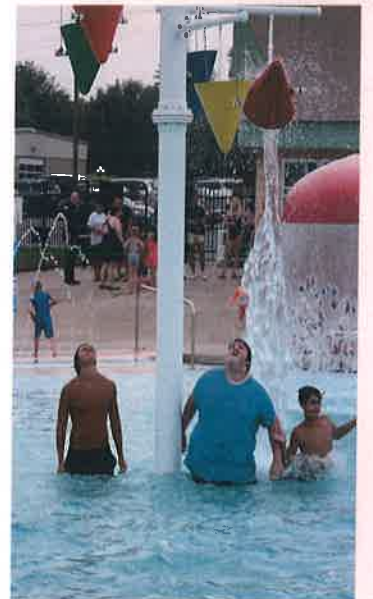
New Police Officer

A Little Reminder

Please remember to return your pets emergency contact form back. Stated in the Pet Policy pets may not be left unattended for more than twenty-four 24 consecutive hours. Pet owner agrees to authorize management to remove the pet should the resident become ill, incapacitated or hospitalized. The name and address of two (2) separate responsible parties to care for the pet in emergency situations must be given to us. The responsible parties should confirm in written and signed statement that they will responsible in case of emergencies for the animal. If the persons named as responsible parties do not follow through with the agreement, management staff may enter the unit and remove the pet and transfer the pet to Animal Control. Any expense to remove and reclaim the pet from any facility will be the responsibility of the resident.
